CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

1. The running order of the stake will be in the order of the draw.
2. More than one nomination or entry may be applied for; but no person can be allocated a second nomination or entry until all applicants have received the offer of a nomination or entry. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.
- 2a. Will all entrants please send a S.A. envelope (9" x 6" C5.) for each Trial entered into, to receive a copy of the draw. This will also be advertised on The Dukeries Gundog Club web site.
3. Entries must be in the hands of the Breed Secretary by the date shown on the schedule. Anyone unable to run must notify the Breed Secretary by telephone. If an entry is accepted and not taken up, the applicant will be liable for full entry fees unless supported by a Veterinary Certificate.
- 3a. Any Owner and Handler who accepts a run in a Field Trial, and fails to attend on the day without acceptable explanation, will result in their nominations / entries going to the bottom of the field trial draws the following season.
4. Substitution for similarly qualified dogs will be allowed. Reserves will be substituted for absentees at advertised time for start of the trial. Competitors should report to the Chief Steward 15 minutes before the time for the start of the trial.
5. There will be a refund of entry fees, less expenses incurred by the Club, if the trial is cancelled.
6. The Field Trial will be held under Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations and thereafter at the discretion of the Judges. The Field Trial Committee for the day will be formed from those of the Field Trial Committee present, plus the Judges ex-officio. The Committee has the power to alter the arrangements, as circumstances require.
The Dukeries (Notts) Gundog Club recommends that all dogs present should be protected against parvo virus and other contagious diseases. No bitch in season nor any dog suffering from a contagious disease will be permitted to be present and must be removed forthwith.
- 6a. The Trial will be deemed to have commenced when announced by the Chief Steward; when all competing dogs and handlers must be present.
7. Only competing dogs or those fulfilling some official activity will be allowed on to the trial ground. All persons are to check with the Chief Steward before exercising their dogs.
8. Unless otherwise stated trophies are kept at the joint responsibility of the winners and the Club for one year. The winner will be responsible for engraving the trophy and for its return to the Breed Secretary before the next succeeding Field Trial. (Clean and in good order!)
9. The Club reserves the right to refuse entries. Competitors and spectators must at all time obey the red flag bearer and are required to be of good behavior at all times facilitating the smooth running of the trial and consideration of the host's property and interests.
10. Persons attending the trial do so at their own risk.
11. Priority in the draw will be given to established members over new members, (i.e. those joining in the current year), then non-members.
12. Members gaining a run in Novice Stake 1 will go to the bottom of the draw in Novice Stake 2. The same system will apply to stakes of other categories. Swapping runs is not allowed.

Please return 2009 Trophies (Clean and in good order!) as soon as possible to the appropriate Breed Secretaries
